



REMOTE LEARNING

What to expect if your child is self-isolating from school

Digital Platform

Your child will be directed to the digital platform being used by the school. Pupils will receive clear direction on how to access their learning and be provided with login details before entering self-isolation.



Daily Content

The daily content will be closely matched to the school curriculum and of equivalent length to the core learning time of a normal school day. This includes direct teaching time and follow on activities. Clear explanations will support pupils to be independent.

Live Teaching

Whilst some schools may use live lessons there is no requirement to do so and pre-recorded teacher led lessons are equally effective.

Feedback & Marking

Teachers will check pupil work regularly and provide feedback that supports their progression. Marking may take different forms including written, oral and self review of work. Teachers will use techniques of assessment that provide them with an accurate picture of pupil achievement.

Communication & Interaction

Schools will communicate with parents through the usual channels and provide opportunities for pupils to interact with teachers when possible. Families with specific issues relating to technology and access should contact the school for assistance and support.
